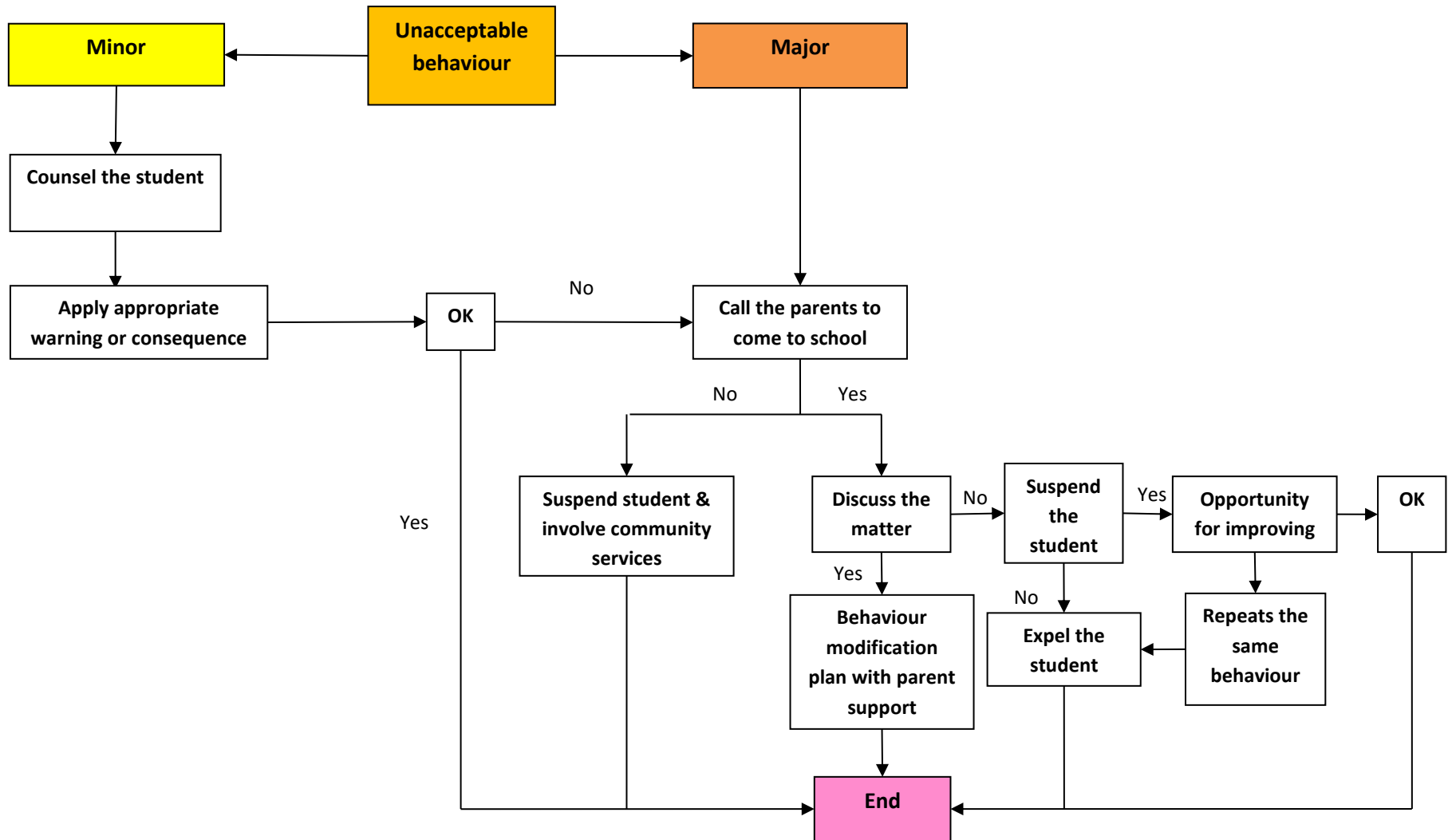


Managing unacceptable behaviour procedure

<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Occasional non-compliance with acceptable use agreements• Occasional non-compliance with classroom protocols and social etiquette• Occasional disruptive behaviour• Occasional outbursts of anger or frustration• Forgetting materials or work assignments• Forgetting PE uniform• Unauthorised use of a mobile phone at school	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Assaulting, coercing, bullying or harassing another student• Defacing or destroying school facilities• Theft• Bringing forbidden items to school• Abusing or insulting a teacher• Leaving the classroom or school• Consistent disruptive behaviour• Consistent unwillingness to work or learn

Prevention of Misbehaviours

Fun, Catching good behavior – creating a positive learning environment using positive language, Positive rewards systems, classroom goal setting, active lessons, differentiation, mutual respect, setting expectations – classroom rules, modeling expected behaviour, classroom rules, fairness and consistency and follow up,
